Dear

As I am writing this letter I am very excited. My church is planning a missions trip to Mexico and guess what? I am going with them!

For seven days we will go and work in the transient work camps of the Mexican Baja, to help some of the poorest people in Mexico. We are planning to go with a team of twenty people of various ages to build shelters, feed the poor, and tell people about the saving grace of Jesus Christ.

Last year we went to the small place called San Vincente, we were building a house for the poor family that you see on the left side of this text. They lived in the "house" right behind them, which is made of cardboard and plastic sheets. They had no washroom and no beds. With the help of so many people we were able to change their future. The Baja California is filled with men and women who are desperately in need for a helping hand. This year, the plan is to build two homes and to provide humanitarian aid in the village. We will also reach out with youth programs and educational presentations. We were also able to connect with the local churches and their youth-group and we will work together with them.

All of us will try to raise the money for the project and for the trip through fundraisers and also through individual donations. We will raise the money for some of the building material through different fundraiser like a Mexican Food Fair and other events, but we still have a long way to go. All the money we raise will go directly to the Missions Project. Every penny will be spent exclusively for this purpose.

We hope that this project will be a great start to serve others and that it may be only the beginning for many other projects. We will also work with the children in the region and provide cloth, simple toys and much needed baby utensils. We also provide the family with school-fees, learning-material and school-uniforms.

For me personally and for our church this is a quite challenging endeavor, and in many ways this is like "braking new grounds". It is a great challenge to go out there and serve "hands on".
